APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please note: Applications will be considered on a rolling basis until the Fund allotment has been expended for that calendar year; applicants should allow at least 4 weeks for consideration and approval. Typically, the scholarship will award up to \$6,000 per year, with a maximum of \$1,500 per individual.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a leader or emerging leader working in and serving the needs of Anne Arundel County communities.

AWARD GUIDELINES

1. Scholarship will be administered by ACDS, and awards will be approved by the AMC Committee consisting of the ACDS Chief Executive Officer or designee; Scholarship Founder, Tara Clifford; Scholarship Honoree Ardath Cade; and an ACDS Board Member.
2. Training must be identified before applying for the scholarship; scholarship funds must be expended within one year of scholarship commitment.
3. Priority will be given to those applicants who plan to obtain certification and/or new credentials and/or to develop or expand specific professional skills.
4. Scholarship may be used only to cover costs for the training/course and/or associated travel, if applicable, and is reimbursable according to the ACDS Training and Professional Development Policies and Procedures.
5. Recipient must provide a brief written summary of the value gained through the professional development opportunity and may be asked to share photos and/or details of their experience during meetings with funders, elected and appointed officials and others.
